There are loads of issues to look into, and even more people to talk to. As soon as we are able, we plan to hold a public meeting at the village hall, and we will be keeping everyone updated with our progress via the village website, leaflet mailings, the Post Office, and Parish notice-boards.

We are working in collaboration with the Parish Council and we also hope to be working with the Community Association, other village groups and businesses, St John's Church and the Primary School and Pre-school.
